

# Terms for Sweetwater Horse Camp Enrollment

## **Age Requirements:**

**Horse Day Camp** - Campers must be between the ages of 7 & 14 during their camp session.

**Advanced Horse Camp** - Campers must be between the ages of 7 & 14 during their camp session

**Pony Time Camp** - Campers must be between the ages of 5 & 6 during their camp session

**Liability Release Forms:** All campers are also required to have a current Liability Release Form on file in the Camp office during their stay. The form will be included with your confirmation packet or can be down loaded off our website [www.sweetwaterhorses.com](http://www.sweetwaterhorses.com) and included with your registration and payment. **The Liability Release Form must be in our office by March 15 for Spring Camp and June 1<sup>st</sup> for Summer Camp.**

**Attire:** For the Camper's safety Boots with a low heel and long pants are required.

**Dismissal of Camper:** The camp reserves the right to dismiss, in it's sole discretion, any camper whose condition, conduct, influence, or behavior is deemed unsatisfactory or detrimental to the best interest of the Camp or her/his fellow campers or who violates Camp rules and regulations, in which case no refunds will be made.

**Discipline of Camper:** Please refer to the CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT.

**Extended Care:** This is a service that is provided for campers who because of transportation issues need to arrive at camp early and/or stay after camp is over. This service needs to be reserved and paid for in full by June 1<sup>st</sup>. There are no refunds and it CANNOT be added after your camper begins camp. Extended Care Hours and Cost per session: 7-9am \$200, 4-6pm \$200. *Please Note: campers not on extended care should be picked up no later than 4:15. Parent(s) will be charged \$1 per minute after 4:15 (after 6:15 for extended care) THIS IS A NON-HORSE related time, campers should bring a book or quiet activity.*

**Pick-up:** Campers will only be released to authorized persons. Photo I.D. may be requested.

**Late Arrival/Early Departure:** No reduction in enrollment fees will be made for late arrival of early departure of camper.

**Medical:** Parent(s) grants permission to utilize medical treatment should the camp staff deem such treatment necessary for the well being of the camper. Parent(s) will pay all medical expenses involved. Parent(s) understands this camp does not provide medical insurance of any kind for the camper.

## **WHEN ILLNESS STRIKES:**

- Staff will evaluate campers.
- Any illness or injury which involves high-sustained fever, repeated vomiting, severe injury, etc. will be reported by phone immediately to the parent/guardian.
- Sick campers will be sent home.
- If camper is to leave camp, parent or guardian will be notified and asked to transport their child home.
- For your benefit (and ours), please don't send children who are already sick to camp.

## **Please Read: Cancellation Policy:**

The camp fee includes a \$200 per session non-refundable/non-transferable deposit. For any cancellation received prior to final payment deadline, the camp fee will be refunded minus the non-refundable deposit (\$200 per session). **In order to provide the highest quality horse program we must plan well in advance based on confirmed reservations. For that reason, after the final payment date for your child's camp session no refunds will be issued for cancellations.** Final payments for spring camp will be due on/before March 15th. Final payments for summer camp sessions will be due on/before June 1st. **\$25 returned check fee.**

## **Important Additional Information:**

It is important for parent(s) and campers to know that we do not allow the following items to be brought to camp. Any of the following items that make their way to camp with your camper will be held safely in the camp office until checkout time.

- All electronics including: Cell phones, ipads, etc.
- Glass bottles
- Pocketknives, or any type of weapon.
